Enable automatic updates for Java

Sun Microsystems release updates to the current Java software version when:

- new functionality is available including bug fixes and new features.
- security risks have been identified in the Java version the client is using which exposes them and the bank to risk.

For security reasons, it is recommended that Java auto updates are enabled on your system.

To ensure that you receive the automatic updates, please complete the following steps:

- Right click on the Start button
- Select Control Panel
- Double click on the Java icon
- Select the Update tab
- Ensure that the checkbox for 'Check for Updates Automatically' is ticked (see screen below).

Click on the **Advanced** button to select when and how often the system should check for updates. An icon will appear in the system tray if an update is available. Move the cursor over the icon to see the status of the update. You will be notified before the update is downloaded.

To force an auto update, click on the **Update Now** button.



Click on the **Install** button to update the Java software version if prompted by the screen below:



The latest software version of Java will be installed. If you select **Later** then you will be reminded after 3 days. This reminder will not disappear until the update available has been installed.
